Tenure-Track Position

Appointment Effective Beginning August 2009

The Composition Department seeks a candidate for a tenure-track faculty position; both senior and accomplished junior applicants will be considered. The successful candidate will be able to work collegially with faculty colleagues, and will be able to inspire gifted young composers in a professionally-oriented educational environment.

RESPONSIBILITIES Teach private lessons in acoustic composition to students at all degree levels; teach ancillary courses such as orchestration and a weekly workshop for composition majors. Although not part of the expected responsibilities, there also exists the possibility of involvement with the Indiana University New Music Ensemble, should the appointee have interest and the necessary experience. Participate actively in the workings of the department, including the recruitment and audition of prospective students; serve on department doctoral committees and school-wide committees.

QUALIFICATIONS Established reputation as a composer based on a record of significant performances and recordings. Demonstrated successful experience in the teaching of composition and related subjects. Completed doctorate required; equivalent professional experience will be given equal consideration.

SALARY AND RANK Commensurate with qualifications and experience. The committee will consider both junior and senior applications, and may recommend appointment at the level of assistant, associate, or full professor.
