**Post-Doctoral Resident Scholar in Collaborative Piano,
String Department**

Tenure-Ineligible, Two-Year Visiting Appointment

Appointment Effective Beginning August 2009

The Indiana University Jacobs School of Music seeks a candidate for a two-year, full-time visiting position as collaborative pianist in the String Department for the academic years 2009-2011. Similar appointments will be advertised separately in the Voice and Woodwind departments.

- RESPONSIBILITIES Duties of the position will be flexible, but will include individual coaching of both the solo and chamber string repertoire with piano, preparing and performing with students in master classes and recitals, and coordinating projects with visiting artists. Residents will teach a course in solo string repertoire with piano accompaniment and string chamber music with piano during each semester of their appointment, resulting in public performances by the participants. Residents will participate in departmental activities as assigned by the chair of the department.
- QUALIFICATIONS A completed doctorate in collaborative piano, or equivalent academic training in an academic institution outside the United States, is required. Candidates must have completed their training or have received the doctorate from an institution other than Indiana University no more than five years prior to their appointment. The successful candidate will demonstrate evidence of artistic accomplishment and technical keyboard skills, fluency in sightreading, a lively intellectual and musical curiosity, and good organizational skills.
- SALARY AND RANK Visiting Assistant Professor; salary is \$42,700 with an annual \$2,000 research and travel budget, and eligibility for the health and retirement benefits available to all full-time faculty.
- APPLICATION Send letter of application, three letters of recommendation, a *curriculum vitae*, and a document (approximately two pages in length) describing your areas of expertise, and proposing specific course topics that would be of interest, to the address below. *Please do not send recordings or other materials unless requested to do so.*
